Restoration ATL 2020 Summer Camp Internship Overview & Application RATL Summer Camp is an 11-week camp that supports mothers transitioning out of homelessness and low-income families. In providing RATL Summer Camp for 10 hours Monday-Friday at no cost, families are able to spend the summer focused on working while their children are in a safe, fun, nurturing environment!

Interns are an essential part of the RATL Team! RATL Summer Interns are college-aged students seeking to grow in areas of leadership, discipleship, and service. As members of the Summer Team, interns are expected to lead daily programming, engage in relationships with RATL Campers and their mothers, connect with volunteers, and offer administrative assistance to RATL Staff.

RATL Summer Camp Intern Overview

- I. Leadership- All interns...
 - A. Reflect the character of Christ in their personal lives and to all staff, children, and mothers involved in RATL Programming.
 - B. Engage in relationships that put a premium on giving dignity to mothers of RATL Campers.
 - C. Set the stage to cultivate healthy relationships between mothers and their children.
 - D. Create a setting that allows children to grow daily in social, spiritual, emotional, and physical health.
 - E. Cultivate a positive, nourishing environment while modeling RATL's mission, vision, and values.
- II. Teamwork- All interns...
 - A. Create an atmosphere of unity through working together and living in community.
 - B. Demonstrate cooperation and initiative in helping summer camp staff and volunteers with carrying out programs.
 - C. Create experiences that engage, educate, and energize campers.
 - D. Enthusiastically engage campers by leading groups of RATL campers through worship, engaging with Bible stories, skits, arts and crafts, recreational activities, and character-building activities.

 - A. Provide a safe, nourishing environment for children to grow
 - B. Lead by example in upholding RATL core values
 - C. Uphold volunteers to safety policies and procedures
 - D. Facilitate daily activities for RATL Campers
 - E. Engage volunteers in day-to-day activities
 - F. Upkeep program facilities and equipment
 - G. Complete assigned responsibilities (daily set up, carry out activities, clean up)
 - H. Develop and maintain relationships with women and children on campus
